The first meetings are dedicated to adults to get to know the educational context and share the children's growth experiences.
The journey continues with the children's welcoming as the weeks go by...

1st WEEK:

It is a time dedicated to the knowledge of the new setting for both the parents and their child. It's a time in which the educators begin to get to know the children and their habits. The constant presence of an adult family member is essential.



2nd WEEK:

During this week the first greetings and first estrangements will begin. The parent waving goodbye entrusts his/her child to the educator and leaves the setting for a few minutes. During this week the experience of lunch with the parent is also offered in the nursery schools.

3rd WEEK:

In these days children will begin to experience a little more extended separation from their parents. Their stay at the nursery school will last until 1.30 p.m.

4th/5th WEEK:

At the beginning of the 4th week the morning experience at the nursery school consolidates and during the same week or in the following one, according to the children's responses, it will begin the afternoon sleep experience for families who ask for it.
